I spoke on the telephone with Helena about workin2 with vou. Governor Bullock, MDC staff, other nonprofit groups and the Cmnnity to repurose the MDC campus for our restorative justice project known as the TreRsure State Treatment and Reformation Center.

Today the "Wealth of Jefferson County" is no longer gold, but the political and economic power lying dormant in the Prisoner Reformation Population is its key to international acclaim and financial prosperit y.

I am asking vou to consult with Governor Bullock to discuss having me transfered to the MDC campus so that together we can meet and discuss strategies about repurposin the MDC campus for FPAI's restorative justic programs.

I am a high profile prisoner. I am one of the surviving protective custody victims Of the September 22 1991 Montana State Prison riot. I have been involved with over twenty-five years of state and federal court intervention safeuarding our rihts and human dignity from the multitudes of state sponsored human rights and civil rights viola tions by various administrators with the Montana Department of Corrections. Many cases continue today.

I have the support of numerous state and federal attorneys. My friend who represented me for the past six years is Helena Montana attorney, Ronald F. Waterman. RFW@GSJW.COM; 442-8560. Mr. Waterman also has endorsed FPAI's Alliance For Restorative Justice Campaign.

Stephen L. Pevar. Senior Staff Counsel with the American Civil Liberties Union has worked to protect me for more than thirty years. He has worked with Mr. Waterman since he arranged for Mr. Waterman's representation in late 2009. He can be contacted at PEVARACLUB@AOL.COM. Or via Mr. Waterman.

I also have the support of Timothy R. Payne Tim_Payne@fd.org (717) 782-3843. Tim is the former Assistant U.S. Attorney for the Civil Rights Office of the United States Department of Justice. Tim brought a federal C.R.I.P.A. Complaint against Montana Department of Corrections in 1994. Tim was also responsible for protecting me throughout the years. Tim is currently an Assistant Federal Public Defender in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.

I have also become dear friends with Helena, Montana Attorney, Frank Crowley fcrowley@doneylaw.com; 443-2211. , Moe Wosepka from the Catholic Diocese of Helena 442-5820; Bob Kolar 449-4653 owner of Helena, Montana's diamond wholesaler www.diamonddream.com and Mr. P. Keating 782-4291 from Criminal Solutions Group. Bob and Mr. Keating are working similar restorative justice projects and I am in close collaboration with them.

I am also a close personal friend of the Adolph Coors family from Colorado. They have supported my human rights advocacy for more than twenty five years. They continue supporting my work today. My list of supporters and references can continue. But to hell with that. I seem to be drifting away from the point I'm conveying to you.

I am very unpopular with the Montana Department of Corrections. They oppose my reform efforts. They go out of their way to fabricate falsehoods about me and in turn punish me for it. It is simply revenge for the decades old rivalry which is ongoing. There are riffs of absurdities and mad humor in it, but the baseline remains a dead serious alienation of the prisoner reformation society the the Department of Corrections has flagged as it's arch nemesis. I have offered olive branches of peace and mutual cooperation with the Department. Sadly, they ignore my peace offerings and refuse to aid me with developing restorative justice programs.

In partnership with Jefferson County Developmental Center Commissioners, MDC staff we can formulate a comprehensive plan that will allow us to redevelop part of the MDC campus.

Jefferson County officials can advocate for funding and political support from state government divisions. I know how to bring in experts from other international APAC facilities, private sector funding and publicity. I need the resources to and technologies to effectively communicate with my supporters and the prisoners rights community. Of course, I have no problem working under the direct supervision of the County Attorneys office who will have access to all accounts and electronic files required for this advocacy to begin,


I don't expect you to fully realize exactly how bringing me to the MDC campus will translate into international support and millions of dollars in funding. Together we will be the nucleus of this partnership. I already have standing with the human rights and prisoner's rights community. I also have the support of Sharman Corner and Charlie McCarthy, top officials with the Montana insurance commission, businessmen and women in Montana, Colorado, Texas and a host of other locations around the globe.

I have legal standing to be transferred to MDC as well as to advocate for any political, human rights and prisoners rights in several Settlement Agreements signed by me, Mr. Waterman and the Montana Department of Corrections. I will explain more about this should you require this information.

Mr. Waterman tried negotiating with the Hardin, Montana Commissioners to house me at their abandoned facility. They declined. I wanted to use that facility in 2013-2014 for the Treasure State Treatment and Reformation Center.

It is imperative for you to consult with Governor Bullock to ask his approval as the head of Montana's Executive Branch of government-which oversees the Montana Department of Corrections- to authorize my transfer and custody to MDC or County officers so that we can work together to develop a plan to bring this vision into reality. I am asking you to have a measure of faith in me.
